### Friday March 27, 2009

**12:00 PM** (Dr. Perry Gerkinis)

**Has the LHC destroyed the Earth yet?:** The world's most powerful proton accelerator, the Large Hadron Collider or LHC, came on-line for a brief period on 10 September 2008 and is due to resume operations this coming summer. While this device has the potential to answer many fundamental questions about the subatomic world, it has also raised some concerns about its potential impact to the Earth. We will discuss the LHC, the science behind it, and the curious public reaction to its activation.

**1:00 PM** (Dr. James P. McClintock)

**The ecological impacts of rapid climate warming on the Antarctic Peninsula:** The presentation begins with an overview of the dramatic changes in the physical environment that are taking place along the Antarctic Peninsula that are related to climate warming. Included are dramatic increases in the rates of glacial recession, increases in major ice sheet breakouts and a reduction in the duration and extent of the the annual sea ice. The presentation then turns to addressing the impacts of these changes on marine life, covering everything from the smallest of plankton to the largest of whales. The presentation ends with a discussion of a model system that demonstrates it is possible to bring nations together

to modify their behaviors to rectify anthropogenic ally-mediated global changes in climate.

**Time Travel:** What prospects are there for time travel in our description of science as we know it? Which science fiction stories do a good job describing time travel? If time travel were possible, what would real-world implications be?

**The Race for Space in the 21st Century:** We will discuss the up-and-coming space programs of Japan, China, and India and their impact on the space programs of Europe, the USA, and Russia. What will be the role of NASA in this new world order? How will we continue to be a major player in space exploration without the shuttle program to take us into orbit on a regular basis? What will be the role of private enterprise?

**Ptolemy's Ptelescope:** Join us as we explore an alternate history in which the telescope was invented in the time of Ptolemy, the ancient Greek philosopher and scientist.

**Hubble's Godparents:** Astronomers have long dreamed of examining the Universe free of the limitations imposed by our atmosphere. The Hubble Space Telescope is the best-known of these space instruments, one which has surpassed its science goals and had a remarkable impact on the public imagination. However, its development stood on the shoulders of a long history of space astronomy, dating back to the use of war-surplus V-2 rockets to study the Sun and going on to include more than 60 satellites and spacecraft, launched by entities around the globe. I trace the development of astronomy from spacecraft, detailing the discoveries, technical advances, and political twists that have gone into opening these new windows to the cosmos. You will hear why air forces were intensely interested in solar X-rays, how the highest X-15 flights had astronomy as mission goals, the race to obtain UV spectra of other stars, what was learned from spectroscopic film recovered from a spacecraft whose occupants were dead, and which satellite's 3-year mission wound up lasting 18.

### The Whole Blood Donation (Classic - 10 minutes)

After completing your "mini-physical" and medical history, you will be directed to a donor chair; after four to eight minutes, you will have donated approximately one pint of blood.

The blood will be separated into different components such as red cells, platelets and plasma. Splitting your blood donation into these components means that your one blood donation can help save the lives of three or more people.

### The Apheresis Donation (30-60 minutes)

In this process, blood is collected from the donor's arm and then separated into different components in a special machine designed for this purpose. The components that are needed are reserved and the other components are returned to the donor. Apheresis can be used to collect any blood component. Most often it is used to collect platelets - the component that is essential for blood clotting

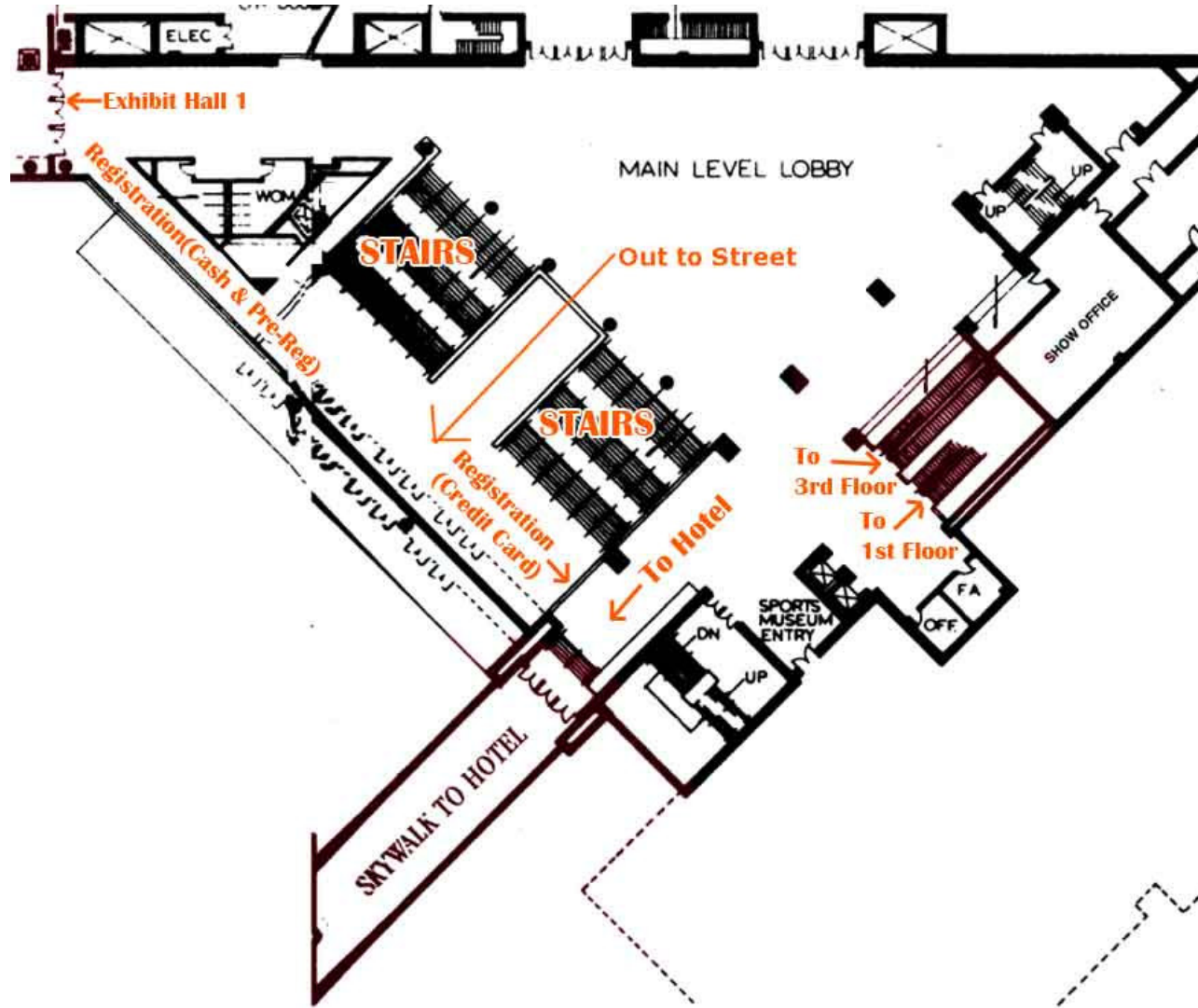

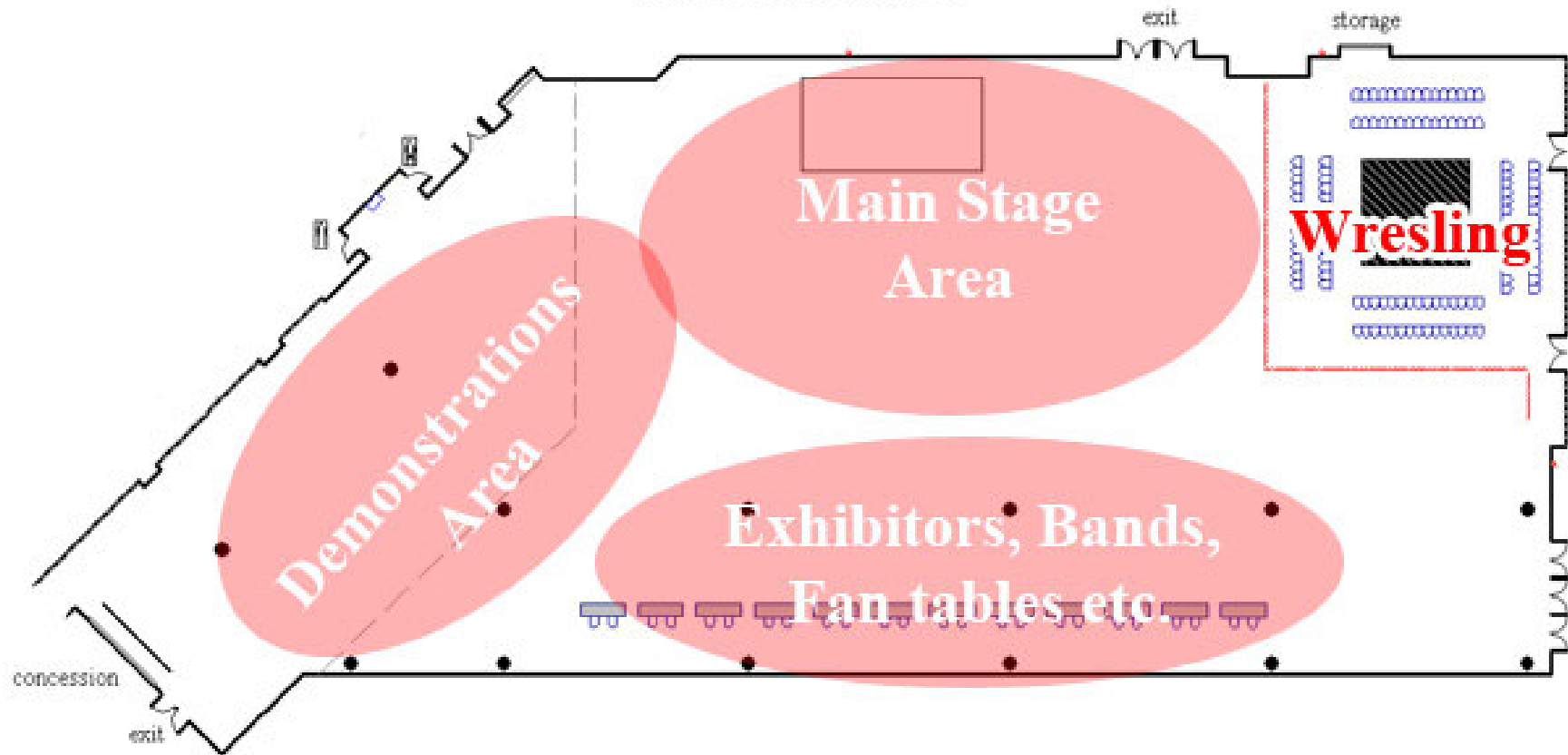

# CONVENTION RULES

---

## **Alcohol and Drugs**

Alcoholic beverages and Drugs of any kind are not permitted in any of the convention areas. Alcoholic beverages are allowed only in designated areas.
